The mural entitled 'Rising' is inspired by the experiences of incarcerated men at Elmwood Correctional Facility and formerly incarcerated men living in South County. The purpose of the art exhibit is to shine light upon these men by providing a platform for their voices to be heard, so that they may share their lived experiences and inspire others to heal by turning pain into transformation through art. The theme of the men's mural project is centered around exploring experiences with fatherhood - as a father and/or experiences with their own fathers.

'Rising' is sponsored by Carry the Vision, County of Santa Clara Office of Diversion and Reentry, County of Santa Clara Office of the Sheriff, and the Gilroy Center for the Arts. The artists participated in Carry the Vision's Living on Purpose Program, which teaches universal life skills for realizing inner awareness through leadership development, restorative circles, deep listening exercises, journaling, meditation, and art.
